- **Reflexive pronouns:** are normally placed in front of the verb,
- *e.g. me lavo los manos.*
- **Direct object pronouns:** are found by ‘asking’ the verb what or who, que o quién, and are also placed in front of the verb,
- *e.g. yo compro un regalo = yo lo compro (regalo is replaced by lo = ‘it’, this happens because you have already referred to the regalo before so the context is already set and you don’t need to repeat yourself).*
- **Indirect object pronouns:** are found by asking who it is for, para quién.
- *E.g. Yo compro este regalo para mi madre = Yo le compro este regalo (para mi madre is replaced by le = her).*
